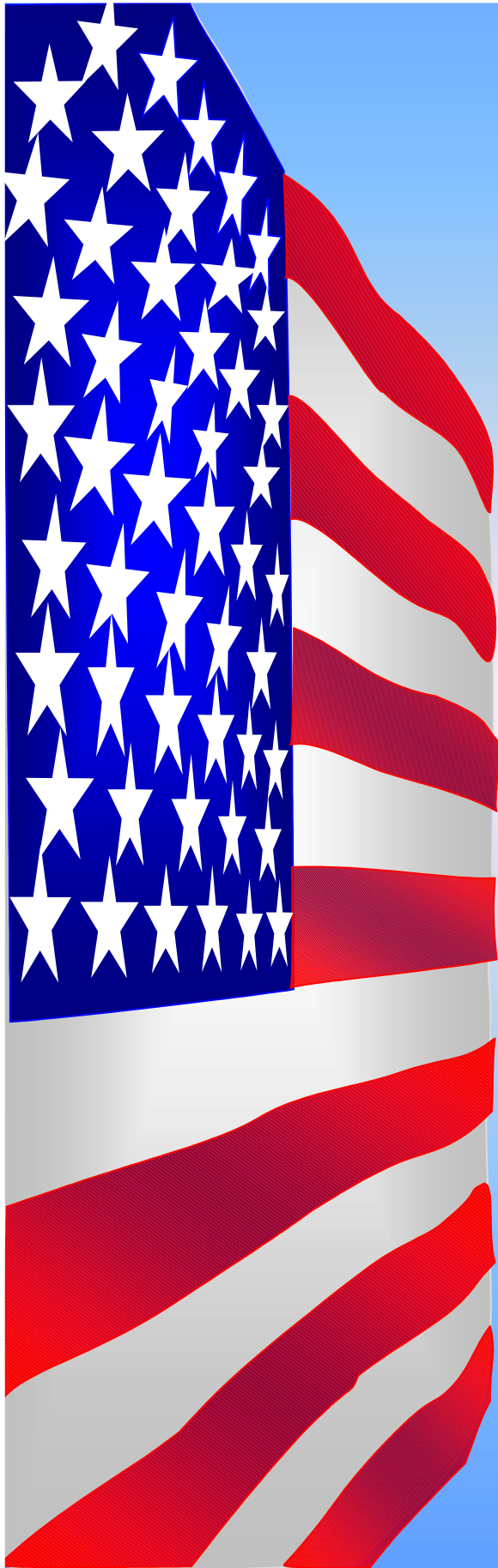

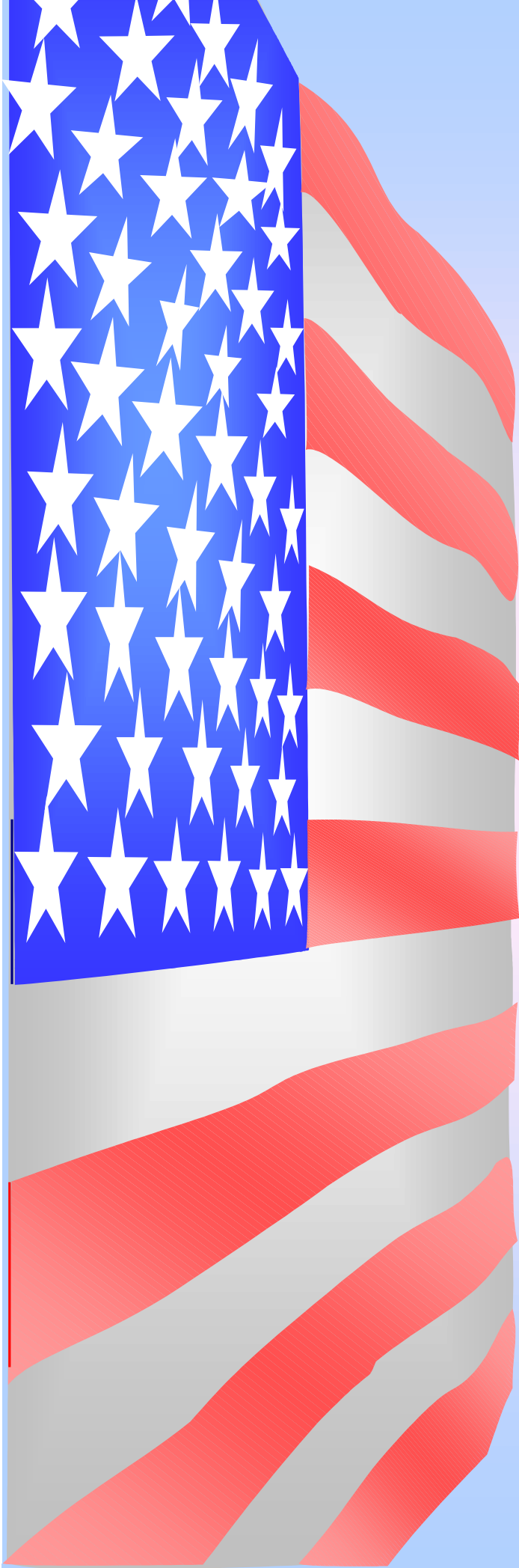
Oh! say can you see,
